
Portions of Isaiah 63-64





According to Tim Keller:

- **Gospel renewal is a life-changing recovery of the Gospel**
- **Personal Gospel renewal: the Gospel doctrines of sin and grace are actually experienced, not just known intellectually**
- **Corporate Gospel renewal (revival): a season in which a whole body of believers experience Gospel renewal together**
- **Revivals/Renewals are necessary because the default mode of the human heart is works-righteousness**
- **All Christians need the Spirit to bring the Gospel home to their hearts for deepened experiences of Christ's love and power**
