Kids' Discipleship Resource: Fall 2020, Week 1

The Ascension

Recap: [Read Acts 1:1–11](#)

Ask:

- **Pre-K to 2nd Grade**
 - What do you think it would be like to see Jesus float up into the sky? What do you think his disciples were feeling?
 - What do we learn about Jesus from this passage?
- **3rd to 5th Grade**
 - Why did Jesus ascend into heaven? Why does that matter for us?
 - What do we learn about Jesus from this passage?

Bonus Activities:

- **Pre-K to 2nd Grade** – Hide a small object around the house, in a place too difficult for kids to find; however, pick one “witness” to your hiding. After the kids look unsuccessfully, have the witness answer questions to direct the others to find the object. Explain to the kids that a witness has seen something with his or her own eyes and can say that it really happened. Use this to think about why it was important for Jesus’ first followers to be witnesses of his resurrection.
- **3rd to 5th Grade** – Look up (some or all): Matt. 28:8–10; Luke 24:13–15, 30–43; John 20:11–29; 21:1–14; 1 Cor. 15:3–8. Have the kids make two lists, one for the people who saw Jesus after his resurrection and another for the things he did in their presence. Use the opportunity to talk about why these “convincing proofs” (Acts 1:3) we have of Jesus’ resurrection are important for our faith.

Read Acts 1:1–11 one more time with your kids

Or read Story 121 in *The Gospel Story Bible*

Or follow 5 days of devotions on pgs. 300–306 of *Old Story New*
