Community Focus:

We lift up our **Haitian brothers and sisters** in our community who face the deep uncertainty and fear surrounding the loss of their Temporary Protected Status (TPS). Comfort families navigating anxiety over their future, protect workers and children, and grant strength to all who feel vulnerable in this time of transition. We pray for the committed work of our friends at the **Everett Haitian Community Center** ministering to and walking alongside so many in uncertainty.

Congregation Focus:

We pray for the **students** that are starting or returning to school in the coming weeks. We ask for safety for those that are traveling, and that the Lord would sustain them as they begin a new semester.

World Focus:

We lift up our World Partner **Roger D.** as he travels to Nicaragua from August 24 through September 16 to serve in remote communities along the Rio Grande de Matagalpa. Pray for safe travel and a fruitful time of ministry. Roger has just completed a water, sanitation, and hygiene curriculum for village primary schools and will be training local staff to implement it. Pray that all instructional materials arrive safely upriver. Pray also for his work equipping community church leaders to reach out to their communities holistically, and for wisdom as he explores the possibility of future agricultural projects in the area.
